Liyana is a genre-defying documentary that tells the story of five children in Eswatini (formerly Swaziland) who turn past trauma into an original tale about a girl named Liyana. The film weaves her animated journey together with poetic documentary scenes to create an inspiring story of perseverance and hope.

Crafted by five orphaned children from Eswatini, it has won more than 25 jury and audience awards and screened at more than 80 film festivals around the world including the British Film Institute's London Film Festival.
